

## DEFEATING YOUR WORST FEARS

### Multiplying your Impact - Part 3

**Exodus 3:7, 10 (NIV)** The Lord said, "I have indeed seen the misery of My people in Egypt. I have heard them crying out because of their slave drivers, and I am concerned about their suffering. So now, GO! I am sending you to Pharaoh to bring My people the Israelites out of Egypt."

**Exodus 3:11 (NIV)** "But Moses said to God, 'Who am I, that I should go to Pharaoh and bring the Israelites out of Egypt

**Exodus 3:13 (NLT)** "But Moses protested, "If I go to the people of Israel and tell them, 'The God of your ancestors has sent me to you,' they won't believe me. They will ask, 'Which god are you talking about? What is his name?' Then what should I tell them?"

**Exodus 3:14-15 (NIV)** GOD'S RESPONSE: God said to Moses, "I am who I am! This is what you are to say to the Israelites: 'I AM has sent me to you... This is My name forever, the name by which I am to be remembered from generation to generation."

**Exodus 4:1 (NLT)** "But Moses protested again, "Look, they won't believe me! They won't do what I tell them. They'll just say, 'The Lord never appeared to you.'"

**Exodus 4:2 (NIV)** GOD'S RESPONSE: "Then the Lord said to him, 'What is that in your hand?' 'A staff,' he replied."

**Exodus 4:10 (NLT)** “But Moses pleaded with the Lord, “O Lord, I’m just not a good speaker. I never have been, and I’m not now, even after You have spoken to me. I’m clumsy with words.”

**Exodus 4:11-12 (NLT) GOD’S RESPONSE:** Then the Lord asked Moses. “Who makes mouths? Who makes people so they can speak or not speak, hear or not hear, see or not see? Is it not I, the Lord? Now GO and do as I have told you. I will help you speak well, and I will tell you what to say.”

**Exodus 4:13 (NIV)** “But Moses said, “O Lord, please send someone else to do it.”

**Exodus 4:14 (NLT) GOD’S RESPONSE:** “Then the Lord became angry with Moses.”

**Ezekiel 33:8 (NLT) God:** “If I announce that some wicked people are sure to die and you fail to warn them about changing their ways, then they will die in their sins, but I will hold you responsible for their deaths.”
