<ul> <li>2 Corinthians 4:17 (Ph) "These little troubles, which are temporary, are winning for us a permanent, glorious and solid reward all out of proportion to our pain."</li> <li>Romans 5:3-4 (LB) "We can rejoice when we run into problems and trials for we know they help us learn to be patient. And patience develops strength of character in us and helps us trust God more each time"</li> </ul>
III. DETERMINE
Wrong Responses

Acts 27:15 " so we gave way to it and were driven along"

<ul> <li>Acts 27:18 " they began to throw the cargo overboard"</li> <li>Acts 27:31-32 "Paul told the centurion and soldiers, `Unless these men remain in the ship, you cannot be saved.' So the soldiers cut away the ropes of the ship's lifeboats and let them fall away."</li> </ul>
3. Difficulties can cause us to
Acts 27:20 " we finally gave up all hope of being saved."
The Right Response
1. Confess
<b>Proverbs 28:13</b> ( <b>LB</b> ) "A man who refuses to admit his mistakes can never be successful. But if he confesses and forsakes them, he gets another chance."
2. Confront
Acts 27:33-34 "Therefore we know we're going to crack up so I encourage you to eat. Take some food."
3. Claim
