FROM DEADEND TO DELIVERANCE The Six Phases of Faith - Part 6

Abraham's example:

DEMENADED

- **Phase 1**: A DREAM: **Genesis 12:1-3** (God) "I will make you into a great nation..."
- **Phase 2:** A DECISION: **Genesis 12:4** "So Abraham left as the Lord had told him to..."
- **Phase 3:** DELAY: **Genesis 16:1** "But Sarah still had not borne any children..."
- **Phase 4:** DIFFICULTY: **Genesis 17:18** "How can a son be born to a man my age?"
- **Phase 5:** DEADEND: **Genesis 21:1-6, 22:1-12** "Take your only son, whom you love, and sacrifice him..."
- **Phase 6:** DELIVERANCE: **Genesis 22:12-14** (God) "Don't hurt the boy...I've provided a lamb..."

What To Do When You Reach a "Deadend"

I. REMEMBER	
Romans 4:17 (LB) "Abraham believed in God who gives life to the	<u>ie</u>
dead and who creates something out of nothing."	
Luke 18:27 "What is impossible with men is possible with God."	
II. RELY ON	

- **Romans 4:18 (Ph)** "When hope was dead within him, Abraham went on hoping in faith... He <u>relied on the word of God</u>..."
- **Hebrews 11:17** (**LB**) "While God was testing him, Abraham <u>still</u> trusted in God and his promises, so he offered his son Isaac..."
- **Romans 4:18 (JB)** "Though it <u>seemed</u> Abraham's hope could not be fulfilled... he <u>did</u> become the father of many nations, <u>exactly as</u> God had promised."

III. FACE THE
Romans 4:19-20a "Without weakening in his faith, he faced the fact that his body was as good as dead and Sarah's womb was also dead. Yet he didn't waver with unbelief" 2 Corinthians 4:8 "We fix our eyes on what is unseen. For what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal."
IV. EXPECT
Romans 4:20-21 (LB) "But Abraham never doubted he <u>praised God</u> for this blessing <u>even before it happened</u> . He was completely sure that God was able to do anything He promised." 2 Corinthians 1:9-10 (Paul) "But this happened so we might not rely on ourselves but on God who raises the dead! He <u>has delivered</u> us He <u>will deliver</u> us (and) we have set our hope that He will <u>continue to deliver</u> us"
