Hebrews 11:23-27 “By faith Moses’ parents hid him for three months after he was born, because they saw he was no ordinary child, and they were not afraid of the king’s edict. By faith Moses, when he had grown up, refused to be known as the son of Pharaoh’s daughter. He chose instead to be mistreated along with the people of God rather than to enjoy the pleasures of sin for a short time. He regarded disgrace for the sake of Christ as of greater value than all the treasures of Egypt, because he was looking ahead to his reward in heaven. By faith he left Egypt, not fearing the king’s anger; he persevered because he saw him who is invisible.”

1. Refuse to be _____.

Hebrews 11:24 (NIV) “By faith, Moses, when he had grown up, refused to be known as the son of Pharaoh’s daughter.”

1 Thessalonians 2:4 (NLT) “Our purpose is to please God, not people. He is the one who examines the motives of our hearts.”

Jeremiah 29:11 (NLT) “I know the plans I have for you,” says the Lord. “They are plans for good and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope.”
