### What God Can Do Through You - Part 1

#### 1. BE \_\_\_\_\_.

**Hebrews 11:24** "By faith Moses, when he had grown up, refused to be known as the son of Pharaoh's daughter."

**Hebrews 11:25** "Moses chose to be mistreated along with the people of God rather than to enjoy the pleasures of sin for a short time."

#### 2. ACCEPT \_\_\_\_\_.

**11:23** "By faith, Moses' parents hid him for three months after he was born because they saw that he was no ordinary child and they weren't afraid of the king's edict."

**Hebrews 11:24b** "When he had grown up."

#### 3. ESTABLISH \_\_\_\_\_.

**Hebrews 11:26** "He regarded disgrace for the sake of Christ as of greater value than the treasures in Egypt because he was looking ahead to his reward."

**Matthew 6:24** "No one can serve two masters. Either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and Money."

**Hebrews 11:27** "By faith, he left Egypt, not fearing the king's anger. He persevered because he saw him who is invisible."

**II Corinthians 4:16** "Therefore we do not lose heart though outwardly we're wasting away yet inwardly we're being renewed day by day for our light and momentary troubles are achieving for us an eternal glory that outweighs them all."

**II Corinthians 4:18** "Therefore, we fix our eyes, not on what is seen but on what is unseen for what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal."
