Ju	dges 15:3-5 "Samson said to them, `This time I have a right to get even with the Philistines. I will really harm them.' So he went out and caught 300 foxes and tied them tail to tail in pairs. Then he fastened a torch to every pair of tails. He lit the torches and let the foxes loose standing in

So Delilah said to Samson, `Tell me the secret of your great strength.'"

Judges 16:16-17a "And with such nagging, she prodded him day after day until he was tired to death. So he told her everything." And that was it.

Judges 16:19-20 "Having put him to sleep on her lap, she called a man to shave off the seven braids of his hair and so began to subdue him and so his strength left him. Then she called, `Samson, the Philistines are upon you.' He awoke from his sleep and thought `I'll go out as before and shake myself free.' But he did not know that the Lord had left him."
