3 KINDS OF PEACE JESUS OFFERS YOU

2 Corinthians 5:18 “God sent Christ to make peace between himself and us.”

Romans 5:1 “Since we are made right with God by faith in Christ, we
have peace with God because of what Jesus has done for us.”

Romans 5:10 “Even though we were his enemies, God made peace with us, because his Son died for our sins. Now that we’re at peace with God, we will be saved for eternity by his Son’s life.”

Colossians 3:15 “Let the PEACE OF GOD rule IN your heart. . . .”

Ephesians 2:16 “Christ brought us all together through his death on the
Cross. The Cross gets us to embrace each other, and end the
hostility between different groups.”

Galatians 3:28 “In Christ’s family there is no division between Jew and
Gentile, slave or free, or even male and female. In Christ we’re
all equal and the same. We’re all in a common relationship with
Jesus.”

Luke 11:35 “Make sure that the light you think you have is not really darkness.”

Isaiah 48:18 “If only you had paid attention to my commands your peace would have flowed like a river.” You’d have more peace than you could imagine.

2. I MUST EXPRESS _____.

James 4:6 “God opposes the prideful but gives grace to the humble.”

Isaiah 26:12 “Lord, grant us PEACE, for all we have, and all we are, has come from you!”

Psalms 34:18 “The Lord is close to those whose hearts are breaking; he rescues those who are humbly sorry for their sins.”

Philippians 4:6-7 “Don’t worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need, and thank him. If you do this, you will experience God’s peace, which is far greater than the human mind can understand. God’s peace will guard your heart and mind as you live in Christ Jesus.”
