- **Daniel 6:3** "Now Daniel <u>so distinguished himself above all the other</u> governors and administrators (satraps) <u>by his exceptional qualities</u> that the king planned to put Daniel in charge of the entire kingdom!"

- **Daniel 6:4** "When the administrators heard the news, they tried to find a reason to undermine Daniel in his work and accuse him of misconduct, but they were unable to do so. They could not find anything to say against him! He was honest, reliable, hardworking, and incorruptible. He was never lazy or negligent in any task."

- **Daniel 6:5** "His coworkers concluded 'Our only chance of finding any grounds to get rid of Daniel will be to find something to accuse in his religious practices.""
- **Daniel 6:6-9** "The officials who wanted Daniel removed from office went to the king and they said, King Darius, live forever! We've convened everyone and we've all agreed that for the next thirty days everyone should pray to you. And we think that you should issue an edict saying that anyone who disobeys your order by praying to anyone else will be tossed into the pit where your lions are kept. And, let's put this decree in writing so it can't be altered or repealed according to the laws of the Medes and the Persians.' That's exactly what King Darius did."
- **Daniel 6:10-11** "When Daniel learned that the new law had been signed, he went home and <u>knelt down to pray as usual</u> in his upstairs room, with <u>its</u> <u>windows wide open</u> toward Jerusalem. He prayed <u>three times a day, just</u> <u>as he had always done his entire life, thanking and praising God</u>. So Daniel's enemies went together to Daniel's house to catch him <u>praying</u> and asking for God's help."

2 Timothy 1:8 "You must <u>never</u> be ashamed to tell others about our Lord. <u>With the strength God gives you</u>, be ready to suffer if necessary to share the Good News."

3. Standing for God _____

Daniel 6:19-23 "At the first light of dawn, the king got up and hurried to the <u>pit filled with lions</u>. When he got there he called to Daniel in an anguished voice, 'Daniel, servant of the living God, has your God, whom you serve continually, been able to rescue you from the lions?' Daniel answered, 'O king! <u>My God sent his angel</u>, and he shut the mouths of the lions, and they <u>have not hurt me at all</u>, because God knew I've done nothing against him or you, O king!' The king was overjoyed and gave orders to lift Daniel out of the pit. And when Daniel was lifted out, there was <u>not a single scratch on his body</u> because he had <u>trusted</u> God."

- Acts 4:13 "When the Council saw <u>the boldness</u> of Peter and John, <u>they were</u> <u>amazed</u>, since they knew they were just ordinary men, <u>but they had been</u> <u>with Jesus</u>!"
- Daniel 6:25-28 "Then King Darius sent this proclamation to every nation, race, and language on earth: 'I decree that the God of Daniel is to be honored and worshiped in every part of my kingdom. For He is the living God and He's the One who endures forever; His kingdom will outlast all the human kingdoms. He is the God who rescues and saves! He does miracles just as He rescued Daniel from the power of the lions.' So Daniel continued to be successful during the reign of King Darius and then in the following reign of Cyrus the Persian."
- Matthew 2:1-2 "After Jesus was born in Bethlehem, wise men from the East came to Jerusalem asking, 'Where is the one who's been born King of the Jews? We saw his star from the East and have come to worship Him.'"

Matthew 5:11-12 Jesus: "Consider yourself blessed if people put you down or throw you out, or speak lies about you <u>because of me</u>.
