YOU'RE INVITED to a Book Discussion Group: By reading and discussing "Keeping Your Kids on God's Side" by Natasha Crain, we'll equip ourselves to empower our kids [or anyone else, for that matter] to respond well to the hard questions that threaten their faith, whether it be at school, with friends or online. Research shows that 60-88% of kids turn away from Christianity during or after their teens. Ms. Crain summarizes the reason as "A lack of robust spiritual training [that] has resulted in featherweight faith...[which] is being blown away by attacks from our secular culture." In *Keeping Your Kids on God's Side*, we'll find "clear, easy-to-understand responses to 40 of the most common challenges kids face" that we can then discuss with our kids. We'll meet 2-3 Sunday evenings a month starting on October 15th, 6:00-7:30, at the Ciccarelli's home in North Torrance (telecon is also an option). The book is ~\$10 per copy.
