(In Your Family, Business, or Church)

1. DEFUSE
Philippians 2:3a "Do nothing out of selfish ambition" Philippians 2:3a (Ph) "Never act from motives of rivalry" Philippians 2:3a (JB) "There must be no competition among you"
James 4:1-2 "What causes fights and quarrels? Don't they come from your desires that battle within you? You want something, but you don't get it."
1st Cause of Conflict:
2. DELETE
<ul> <li>Philippians 2:3b "Do nothing out of vain conceit."</li> <li>Philippians 2:3b (Ph) "Never act from motives of personal vanity"</li> <li>Philippians 2:3b (GN) "Don't do anything from a cheap desire to boast"</li> <li>Proverbs 13:10 "Pride only breeds quarrels."</li> </ul>
2nd Cause of Conflict:
3. DECREASE
<b>Philippians 2:3c</b> " in humility consider others better than yourselves."

## Humility is not thinking less of yourself, but rather

James 4:11-12 "Anyone who speaks against his brother or judges him speaks against the Law and judges it. There is only one Lawgiver and Judge. Who are you to judge your neighbor?"
3rd Cause of Conflict:
4. DEMONSTRATE
<ul> <li>Philippians 2:4 "Each of you should <u>look</u> not only to your own interests, but also to the interests of others."</li> <li>I Peter 3:7 "Husbands, in the same way be <u>considerate</u> as you live with your wives so that nothing will hinder your prayers."</li> </ul>
4th Cause of Conflict:
5. DEVELOP
<ul> <li>Philippians 2:5 "Your attitude should be the same as that of Jesus Christ."</li> <li>Philippians 2:6 "Who being in the very nature of God did not consider equality with God something to be grasped."</li> <li>Philippians 2:7 "But made Himself nothing, taking the very nature of a servant being made in human likeness."</li> <li>Philippians 2:8 "And being found in appearance as a man He humbled Himself and became obedient unto death, even death on the cross."</li> </ul>
5th Cause of Conflict:
<b>Ephesians 4:3 (GN)</b> "Do your best to preserve the unity which the

Spirit gives, by the peace that binds you together."
