Proverbs 11:14 (LB) “Without wise leadership, a nation is in trouble.”

Romans 6:13 (LB) “Give yourselves completely to God – every part of you – for you want to be tools in the hands of God, to be used for His good purposes.”

Hebrews 11:23-27 “By faith Moses’ parents hid him for three months after he was born because they saw he was no ordinary child. They were not afraid of the king’s edict. By faith Moses when he had grown up refused to be known as the son of Pharaoh’s daughter. He chose to be mistreated along with the people of God rather than to enjoy the pleasures of sin for a short time. He regarded disgrace for the sake of Christ as of greater value than the treasures of Egypt, because he was looking ahead to his reward, and by faith he left Egypt not fearing the king’s anger. He preserved because he saw Him who was invisible.”
