Mark 11:24 Jesus: “Anytime you ask for anything in prayer, believe that you HAVE received it, and you WILL receive it.”

2 Chronicles 20:1-5 “After this, 3 enemy nations united to attack King Jehoshaphat. 2 Chronicles 20:7b “And also, **DID YOU NOT** give this promised land to your friend Abraham’s descendants, to be theirs forever?”

• **Ask God for** _____!

2 Chronicles 20:10-12a “Our enemies want to destroy us. **WILL YOU NOT** stop them from defeating us?”

2 Chronicles 20:12b “Lord, we are powerless against this mighty army that is coming to attack us and we don’t know what to do **BUT** we are looking to you for help.”

2 Chronicles 20:13 “Then all the men of Judah stood before the Lord, waiting with their wives and young children and even babies.”

3. Listen to what _____.

2 Chronicles 20:15b-18 “This is what the Lord says to you: ‘Do not be afraid or discouraged because of this vast army. For the battle is not yours, but God’s!’ ... You won’t need to fight in this battle! Just take up your position and stand strong! Then just wait and watch, and you will see the Lord deliver you! Again, do not be afraid or get discouraged, because the Lord is with you! Then the King and everyone else all bowed down on the ground and worshiped God!”

2 Chronicles 20:21 “Then the king appointed musicians and singers in choir robes TO MARCH IN FRONT OF THE ARMY and loudly praise and thank the Lord! This is what they sang: ‘WE THANK GOD! His love never quits!’”

2 Chronicles 20:22-23 “AT THE MOMENT they began to sing and to praise, THE LORD caused the armies of Ammon, Moab, and Mount Seir to begin fighting among themselves, and they destroyed each other!”

5. Expect God to _____.

2 Chronicles 20:24-26 (NIV) “When the army of Judah finally arrived at the battleground, the valley was covered with dead bodies for as far as they could see. No one had survived. So they went out to gather the plunder and they found huge amounts of equipment, clothing, and other valuables — more than they could carry back! In fact, there was so much loot it took three days to collect it all! On the fourth day, they gathered for a worship service in that valley, which they named ‘The Valley of Beracah’ because the people had thanked and praised God there.”

2 Chronicles 20:27 "Then Jehoshaphat led his troops back to Jerusalem where they joyfully celebrated the great victory that God had given to them."

2 Chronicles 20:29-30 "When the nations surrounding Israel heard how God had fought and defeated the enemies of His people, those nations were all afraid to attack so Jehoshaphat enjoyed peace and security for the rest of his reign as king.”
