# WHAT TO DO WITH A BROKEN HEART

## 1. GET \_\_\_\_\_

Ecclesiastes 4:10, 12 (NLT) "If one person falls, another can reach out and help. But <u>people who are alone when they fall</u> are in real trouble... two can stand back-to-back and conquer. Three are even better."

# 2. ACCEPT

**2 Samuel 12:22-23** "I fasted and wept while the child was alive... But why should I fast when he is dead? Can I bring him back to life?"

# 3. CRY OUT \_\_\_\_\_

- Psalms 142:1-6 (NLT) "I cry out to the Lord; I plead for his mercy. I pour out my complaints before him and <u>tell him all</u> <u>my troubles</u>. For I am overwhelmed, and <u>you alone know the way I should turn</u>..."
- **Psalms 34:18 (NIV)** "The Lord is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit."
- Hebrews 4:16 (NIV) "Let us approach [God] with confidence, so we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need."

### 4. LISTEN TO \_\_\_\_\_

- Psalms 119:25 (LB) "I am completely discouraged... Revive me by your word."
- **Psalms 119:148 (LB)** "I stay awake through the night, thinking about your promises."

#### 5. ASK FOR AND OFFER \_\_\_\_\_

- **Psalms 38:4, 18 (NLT)** "My guilt overwhelms me -- it is a burden too heavy to bear... But I confess my sins; I am deeply sorry for what I have done."
- **Ephesians 4:31-32 (NIV)** "Get rid of all bitterness... forgiving each other just as in Christ God forgave you."
- Job 18:4 (GN) "You are only hurting yourself with your anger."

## 6. KEEP HOPING, GROWING, AND FOCUSING ON

- Psalms 27:13 (NAS) "I would have despaired unless I had <u>believed</u> that I'd see the goodness of the LORD..."
- Philippians 1:6 (LB) "God who <u>began</u> the good work within you <u>will keep right on helping you grow in his grace</u> until his task within you is finally finished..."
- Job 11:13-16 (GN) "Put your heart right, reach out to God... then face the world again, firm and courageous. Then all your troubles will fade from your memory..."
- 2 Corinthians 7:10 (NLT) "God sometimes uses sorrow in our lives to help us turn away from sin and seek salvation."
