_____ for who He is, what He's done, what He's said, and what He's promised to do!

Mark 12:29-30 Jesus: "The most important command of all is this one: You must love the Lord your God with all your heart, and all your soul, and all your mind, and all your strength!"

WHY DO WE EXPRESS OUR LOVE TO GOD?

1. BECAUSE _____.

1 John 4:19 (NCV) "We love because God first loved us!"

Ephesians 1:4-5 (NLT) "Long ago, even before he made the world, God loved us and chose us in Christ to be holy and without fault in his eyes. His unchanging plan has always been to adopt us into his own family by bringing us to himself through Jesus Christ. And this gave him great pleasure."

2. BECAUSE _____.

1 Chronicles 29:14 David: "These gifts did not really come from me and my people. Everything comes from you; we can only give you back what you have given us!"

3. BECAUSE _____.

Psalm 73:16-17 David: "I tried to understand it all, but it was too hard for me to see until I went to the Temple of God. Then I understood what was happening..."

4. BECAUSE _____.

Psalm 18:28-32 (CEV) "You, Lord, keep my lamp burning and turn darkness to light. You help me defeat the enemies of my life. Your way is perfect, Lord, and your word is correct. You are a shield for those who run to you for help... You give me strength and you guide me right!"

WHAT KIND OF WORSHIP DOES GOD LOVE?

2 Chronicles 31:21 (GW) “Hezekiah dedicated his life to serving God. Everything he did in worship in God’s temple, he did wholeheartedly. As a result, he was very successful and prospered.”

Isaiah 29:13 GOD: “These people SAY they are mine, but they honor me only with their lips! Their hearts are far away from me! And their worship of me amounts to nothing more than human traditions that they have memorized and say by rote!”

John 4:23 (NIV) Jesus: “True worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth! That’s the kind of worshipers the Father seeks.”

HOW TO TELL GOD YOU LOVE HIM (WAYS TO WORSHIP)

1. BY ---

Deuteronomy 31:12 (NCV) “Gather ALL the people together: men, women, children, and immigrants living in your towns so everyone can listen and learn to respect the Lord and carefully obey everything in his Word.”

Psalms 85:8 “I listen carefully to what God, my Lord, is saying for he speaks peace to his people and his faithful ones.”

John 13:17 (NIV) Jesus: “Now that you KNOW these things, you will be blessed IF you DO them!”

2. BY ---

Psalms 32:11(MSG) “Celebrate God! SING TOGETHER—everyone! All of you with honest hearts, raise the roof!”

3. BY ---

Acts 1:14 (NIV) “They all joined TOGETHER constantly in prayer.”

Romans 1:12 (NCV) “We must help each other with the faith we have. Your faith will help me, and my faith will help you.”

4. BY

1 Corinthians 10:16 “When we drink from the cup at the Lord's Table, it means that we are SHARING TOGETHER the blessing of Christ's blood. And when we break and eat the bread TOGETHER, it shows that we are SHARING TOGETHER in the Body of Christ.”

5. BY

Romans 12:1 “Because of God’s great mercy to you, offer your lives as living sacrifices to Him, dedicated to serving him in a holy and pleasing way -- this is your spiritual act of worship.”

6. BY

1 Corinthians 16:2 (LB) “On every Lord's Day each of you should put aside something from what you have earned during the week, and give it back as your offering. The amount depends on how much the Lord helped you earn.”

7. BY

Romans 6:3 (Mes) "When we went under the water, we left the old country of sin behind, and when we came up out of the water, we entered into the new country of grace."

Colossians 2:12 (MSG) “Going under the water was a burial of your old life; coming up out of it was a resurrection, God raising you from the dead as he did Christ.”

Galatians 3:27 (Mes) "Your baptism in Christ was not just washing you up for a fresh start. It also involved dressing you in an adult faith wardrobe."

Ephesians 2:22 (NIV) “In Christ’s Body you are being built together to become a dwelling in which God lives by his Spirit.”
