WHY SHOULD I FORGIVE?

1. BECAUSE
Ephesians 4:32 (NIV) "Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you."
2. BECAUSE
Job 5:2 (GN) "To worry yourself to death with <u>resentment</u> would be a <u>foolish</u> , <u>senseless</u> thing to do."
Ecclesiastes 7:9 "It's foolish to hold a grudge."
Job 18:4 (GN) "You are only hurting yourself with your anger!"
Job 21:23-25 (GN) "Some men stay <u>healthy</u> until the day they die others have <u>no happiness at all</u> ; they live and die with <u>bitter hearts</u> ."
3. BECAUSE
Matthew 6:15 (NIV) "For if you forgive men when they sin against you, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. But if you do not forgive men their sins, your Father will not forgive your sins."
HOW SHOULD I FORGIVE?
1. RECOGNIZE
Ecclesiastes 7:20 (NLT) "There is not a single person in all the earth who is always good and never sins."

2. RELINQUISH

- **Romans 12:19 (LB)** "... Never avenge yourselves. Leave that to God, for he has said that he will repay those who deserve it."
- Matthew 18:21-22 (NLT) "Peter asked, `Lord, <u>how often</u> should I forgive someone who sins against me? Seven times?' `No,' Jesus replied, `seventy times seven!'"

3. RESPOND

- **Luke 6:27-28 (NIV)** "... <u>do good</u> to those who hate you, <u>bless</u> those who curse you, and <u>pray for</u> those who mistreat you."
- 1 Corinthians 13:5 (NIV) "Love keeps no record of wrongs."

4. REFOCUS

Job 11:13-16 (LB) "Put your heart right, <u>reach out to God</u>... then <u>face</u> the world again, firm and courageous. Then all your troubles will <u>fade from your memory</u>, like floods that are past and remembered no more."
