Nu	mbers 13:32-33 (NLT) They said, "The land we explored DEVOURS those living in it! ALL the people we saw there are of great size! We SAW GIANTS there! We seemed like grasshoppers IN OUR OWN EYES, and we looked the same to them!"

	mbers 14:1-2 "Then all the people began weeping aloud, and they cried all night. And they grumbled and complained in a great chorus against their leaders, Moses and Aaron. 'We wish we'd died in Egypt, or even here in the wilderness!' they wailed."
